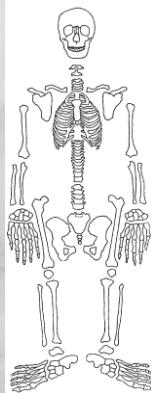


## What information do we need prior to analysis?

- national grid reference
- plans of the site
- *in situ* skeleton recording sheets
- *in situ* photos
- dates/phasing
- grouping
- grave goods
- coffins
- likely period
- samples taken
- context information for disarticulated bone/cremation burials
- do you want us to AMS sample
